- If you arrive by **train**, it's easiest for you to take subway line U7 (Direction: Ostfildern) and at Ruhbank/Fernsehturm change to bus line 70 (Seemühlenweg or Plieningen Garbe) until bus stop Plieningen Garbe.
- If you arrive by **plane**, take the bus 122 (Direction: Esslingen ZOB) and switch to line 70 (Ruhbank Fernsehturm) at Plieningen Post. Leave the bus at Plieningen Garbe. Alternatively, take a taxi (17 Euro).
